



Nexif Energy Australia Lincoln Gap Windfarm Sponsorship Program Guidelines

The Lincoln Gap Wind Farm is a 212MW wind farm project with 35 Senvion wind turbines, 24 Vestas wind turbines and 10MW grid scale battery storage under construction by Nexif Energy Australia Pty Ltd, located near Port Augusta in South Australia.

Nexif Energy is committed to creating enduring and meaningful relationships with the communities in which they operate.

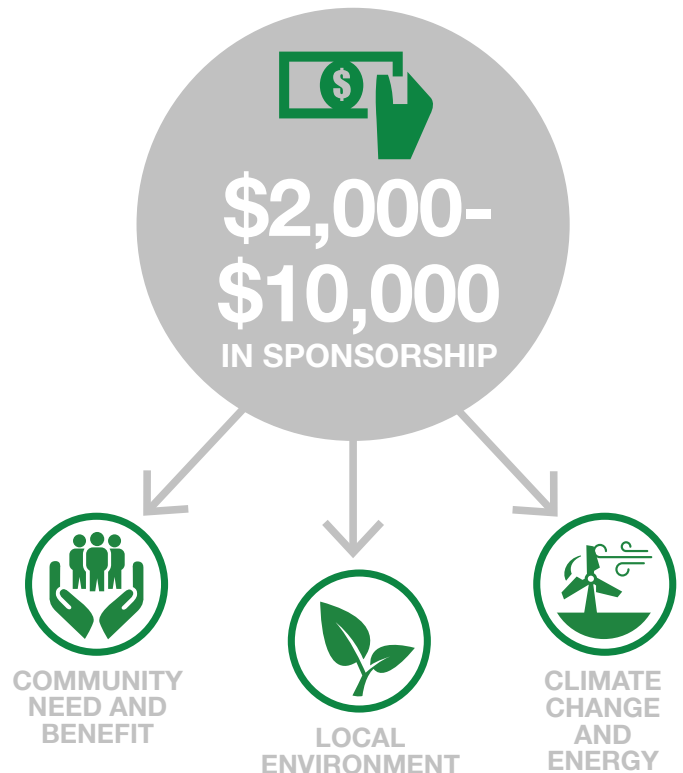
The purpose of the Lincoln Gap Windfarm Sponsorship Program is to provide financial support to eligible groups and organisations for activities that benefit the Port Augusta community.

Who can apply?

Community groups or organisations in the Port Augusta Council area including:

- Incorporated associations
- Not-for-profit companies limited by guarantee
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Corporations (under the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Act 2006)

Although the above applicant types are preferred, successful applicants will be chosen at the discretion of Nexif.

What will be funded?

Eligible groups and organisations can apply for **\$2,000 to \$10,000** in sponsorship for activities that are based in the Port Augusta Council area and:

- Address a community need or are of benefit to the local community and enhance the lives of those living in the area; or
- Benefit the local environment, respond to climate change or demonstrate sustainable energy use or generation.

Meeting these conditions does not guarantee funding. Approval will be at the discretion of Nexif.

What will not be funded?

- Activities outside of the Port Augusta Council area
- Activities that are for individual/private benefit or operating on an expected profit basis
- An activity that does not comply/is not supported by the local Council (if appropriate)
- Political lobbying
- Activities that denigrate or exclude groups in the community
- Dangerous or unsafe activities
- Reimbursement for funds already spent
- Interstate or overseas travel
- Funding requests for general fundraising activities.

What is the application and approval process?

Applications open on 1 March 2022 and close on 31 March 2022.

Applications can be made by:

- Filling out and submitting the application form along with any required attachments by 31 March 2022 to: *Lincoln Gap Wind Farm Construction Director John Smith* at Email: LGWF.Mail@Nexif.com
- Nexif will review all applications against the assessment criteria (see below) and announce successful applicants in May 2022.

How are applications assessed?

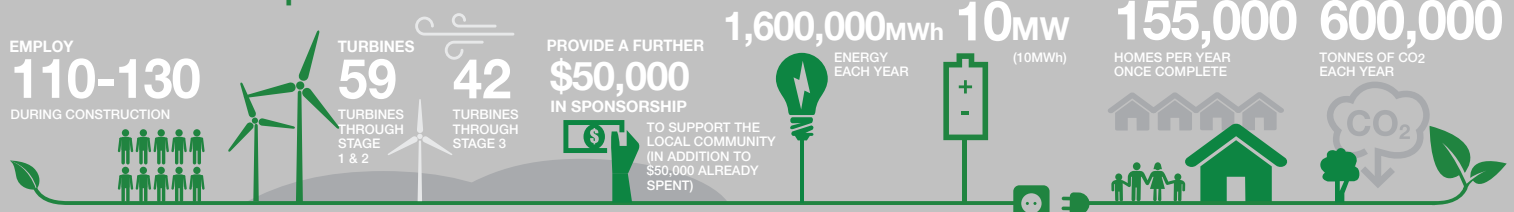
Once submitted, an application will be assessed according to:

- Eligibility
- How well the assessment criteria (below) are met
- Available funding.

Assessment Criteria	Description
Community	The extent to which the proposed activity(ies) address a community need or are of benefit to the local community and enhance the lives of those living in the area
Environment & Sustainability	The extent to which the proposed activity(ies) benefit the local environment, respond to climate change or demonstrate sustainable energy use or generation
Promotion	The extent to which the proposal will promote Nexif and the Lincoln Gap Windfarm
Capacity	The ability of the applicant to deliver the proposed activity and manage the finances

Nexif reserves the right to request further information in considering any application, as well as the right to reject any application.

The Lincoln Gap Wind Farm will...



Notification and payment

All applicants will be notified via email of the outcome of their application.

Prior to payment all successful applicants will be required to:

- Provide Nexif with a copy of the organisation's Public Liability Insurance "Certificate of Currency" (minimum \$20 million) noting Nexif as an interested party
- Provide a tax compliant invoice for the agreed amount of funding plus GST (10%) (if registered for GST)
- Sign a letter of sponsorship agreement detailing the terms and conditions of the sponsorship for funding.

Reporting

Successful applicants will be required to expend their funding in line with the sponsorship agreement and keep records of all expenditure.

At the end of the project/activity applicants will be required to submit a brief report outlining the outcomes of the sponsorship, how it was expended and to provide evidence of the expenditure.

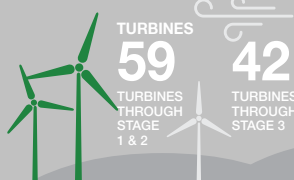
